

What we did...

In May 2007, Stagecoach undertook a major review of the bus network across Barnsley and the Dearne Valley. This resulted in us providing a revised network that offers new routes, extended routes, timetable changes with improved reliability and frequency on some services. New buses were also introduced along with cheaper weekly Megarider tickets for Barnsley and the Dearne Valley.

The achievements gained...

As a result of these changes, the Stagecoach bus network has seen a 5.3%* increase in passenger numbers, and is providing a much improved service for the people of Barnsley.

What's happening now...

As stated at the time, we want to ensure our passengers see improvements in our services and we will continue to make these services even better over time, therefore, from Saturday 26 January 2008, there will be further changes to a number of our bus services across Barnsley.

These include minor timetable change to improve reliability and minor route changes to meet the needs of our customers.

NEW BUSES going your way...

Stagecoach Yorkshire will be introducing new low floor easy access buses onto routes 32, 35, 37 and 222. In addition route 229 will gain low floor easy access buses on all journeys and the busiest journeys on routes 66 and 229 will gain low floor double deck buses.

7 / 7A	Barnsley – Blacker Hill Minor route change, this service will now operate via Worsbrough Village in place of the A61 (Sheffield Road).
32	Barnsley – Cudworth Minor timetable change to improve punctuality.
35	Barnsley – Pontefract Minor timetable change to improve punctuality.
36	Barnsley – South Emsall Minor timetable change to improve punctuality.
37	Barnsley – Grimethorpe Minor timetable change to improve punctuality.
46 / 47	Barnsley – Pontefract Minor timetable change to improve punctuality.
65	Barnsley – Great Houghton Service withdrawn and replaced in part by revised service 227 in the evening and on Sundays.
66	Barnsley – Hoyland Minor timetable change to improve punctuality. Evening and Sunday journeys will all run 10 minutes earlier.
68 / 69	Barnsley – Darfield Minor route and timetable change to improve punctuality.
92	Barnsley – Cawthorne Minor timetable amendment, the 0715 will run 10 minutes earlier throughout.
95	Barnsley - Kexbrough Two new early morning journeys introduced at 0615 and 0630 from Barnsley.
218	Barnsley – Rotherham All evening and Sunday journeys will run 20 minutes earlier to improve coordination with the new 221 between Rotherham and Mexborough. Extra journeys introduced to and from Rotherham on Saturday mornings.
222	Barnsley – Doncaster Revised timetable to improve punctuality, now up to every 30 minutes. Now serves the Denaby and Conisbrough areas providing new links to Barnsley and more buses to Doncaster from these areas. This service will no longer serve Conisbrough Railway Station. In Wath all journeys will operate via Newhill rather than Burman Road. Combined with services 220 and 221, buses will operate up to every 10 minutes between Denaby, Conisbrough and Doncaster.
223	Barnsley - Doncaster Service withdrawn, but replaced with improved 30 minute frequency on service 222.
226	Barnsley – Thurnscoe Route and timetable changes. Buses will now operate between Barnsley and Thurnscoe only, therefore no longer serving Great Houghton. In Thurnscoe buses will follow a one way loop from Shephard Lane via Houghton Road, Merrill Road, Lingamore Leys, School Street and Houghton Road back to Shepherd Lane (in a clockwise direction). Between Brampton and West Melton buses will operate via Pontefract Lane, Barnsley Road, Grove Road, Edward Road, Masefield Road, Christchurch Road, Brampton Road and Melton High Street (replacing service 229).
227	Rotherham – Hoyland Evening and Sunday journeys extended to Barnsley via Jump, Wombwell and Aldham House to partly replace changes to routes 65 and 222.
228	Barnsley – Rotherham Service withdrawn, but replaced by improved 30 minute frequency on service 229.
229	Barnsley – Rotherham Route and timetable changes to improve reliability, now up to every 30 minutes. Between Brampton and West Melton buses will operate direct via Brampton Road and West Melton High Street. The Masefield Road area will be covered by Service 226. This service will no longer serve Meadowhall.
265	Barnsley – Sheffield Additional weekday peak journeys introduced. Timetable amendments to improve punctuality. Earlier first bus from Barnsley to Sheffield every day.
X19	Barnsley – Doncaster – Robin Hood Airport Minor timetable change to improve punctuality. Earlier bus on Mondays to Fridays departing Doncaster for Barnsley at 0430.
